The transcript must indicate that the missing course is currently in-progress of completion. Students who have registered for Langara courses before their final secondary school grades are received, must complete this form and submit the necessary documentation in order to maintain their course registration. Students who have not graduated and have not been approved for conditional admission will be removed from any courses they have registered for.
