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The Rose & Nicholl 6-step Plan: (2) Acquiring the Information

Three sensory tools we can use for learning:

VISUAL LEARNER (VISION SENSE)



Enhance this with:

- Pictures
- Color
- Images
- Visual tools/media
- Diagrams
- Mindmaps
- Flashcards
- Any visual tools

AUDITORY LEARNER (HEARING/SOUND)



Enhance this with:

- Study partners/gps
- Recite info aloud
- After skimming chapter, recite what you know aloud
- Read chapter aloud if possible
- Read flashcards aloud

KINESTHETIC LEARNER (PHYSICAL INVOLVEMENT)



Enhance this with:

- Visualize yourself “doing” what you are learning
- “Pointing” when reading
- Diagrams & sketches
- “Role Play” your learning

THREE GENERAL APPROACHES YOU CAN USE:

1. See what sense(s) you use most: amplify that sense(s).
2. Start using and developing more of your other senses.
3. Multiply your learning: use all three senses (visual, auditory, and kinesthetic).
